Nose: Rich lilac and sun baked straw. Palate: Fresh lime. Touch of minerality. Classic varietal finish. Dry, light – medium body with crisp acidity. Aged in stainless steel.

Nose: Bright citrus. Palate: Lemon-lime, grapefruit and orange. Balanced acidity. Fresh, crisp finish.

Color: Deep, dark purple. Nose: Berries and cocoa. Palate: Coffee, chocolate, blueberries and raspberries. Rich and balanced. Full body.

Purple Heart red blend **48 / 13**
California (Napa Valley) / **Purple Heart Foundation**
Color: dark ruby / opaque. Nose: mulberries, plums and blackberries. Palate: medium body. Lush texture. Red and black fruits. Hints of cardamom. Long, velvet mouth feel. Balanced tannins.

Dreaming Tree Sauvignon Blanc **38**
California (sustainable)

Nose: Passion fruit and kiwi. Palate: Crisp and clean with hints of grapefruit and zesty lime on the finish.

Gerard Bertrand Cotes des Roses White Blend **38**
French

Color: Yellow with golden tint. Nose: Fresh and intense citrus, exotic fruits and flowers. Few notes of candy, pear and pineapple. Palate: Clear mineral backdrop with full body.

Nederburg Chenin Blanc **30**
South Africa

Color: Light gold with a greenish tinge. Nose: Fragrant and floral with nuances of coconut, apricot, orange peel, white stone fruit and peach. Palate: Fruit with a creamy finish.

Tie Dye Red Blend **45**
California

Color: Intense ruby. Nose: Luscious black currant, dark cherry, boysenberry, raspberry and blueberry followed by cedar, caramel, clove, cinnamon and a hint of roasted coffee. Palate: Composed layers of pure berry followed by tanins and silky mouthfeel. Spice on the finish. Complex layers.

Canoe Ridge Cherry Street Red Blend **47**
Washington

Color: Cherries and plums mixed with blackberry and toffee notes. Palate: Berries followed by fine tannins and hints of vanilla.

Luigi Bosca Malbec **52**
Argentina

Color: Intense ruby red. Nose: Coffee beans, vanilla, tobacco, ripe red fruit and spice. Palate: Well structured. Ample volume and mouthfeel. Soft, sweet tannins and balanced acidity. Fruit on the silky finish.

Barossa Valley Estate GSM **38**
Australia

Color: Ruby red. Nose: Fragrant violet with a burst of red berries. Palate: Berries followed by smooth and velvet texture. Hint of black pepper on the finish.
